FOR THE POSITION OF
INSTITUTE FOR SACRED PSYCHOLOGY DIRECTOR**

The **Institute for Sacred Psychology (ISP)** is a program of **Institutes for Christian Spirituality**, a 501(c)3 organization serving an international clientele, particularly in the areas of peacebuilding and education. The mission of ISP is to facilitate a conversation between spirituality and psychology on what it means to be human and to promote a vision of humanity that is both spiritually and scientifically grounded.

The **ISP Director**:

1. Serves as a director on the governing board of the parent organization, **Institutes for Christian Spirituality (ICS)**.
1. Must subscribe personally to the WCI Creed, the foundational document underlying all of the work of the organization.
2. Is immediately responsible to the President of ICS and must work in collaboration with him or her.
3. Is responsible for developing and administering the programs of ISP.
4. Prepares article for publication in the ICS journal, *En Christo*, and in other psychological and spiritual publications
5. Facilitates workshops and seminars on a new vision of humanity current rosters and regular communications with IIR participants.
6. Writes announcements and brief articles on sacred psychology for *ICS Peace Memo*.

This is a volunteer position until such time as grant funding designated specifically for the ISP Director position becomes available.
